# Join Cub Pack 58... Boys & Girls, K-5!

In 2024-25, total dues are approximately \$225. HOW TO JOIN:



1. **New Cubs submit an on-line application & pay National dues of \$150** via QR Code or URL: <https://my.bsa.us/415paa0058mb>  
Following successful on-line Registration, the Pack will assign your Cub to a "Den" and the leader will invite you to the meetings.
2. **Returning Cubs will get an email to log-in to BSA and pay the \$150 National portion of dues.** Depending on when you joined, this may be in the fall or spring.
3. **Pay Pack 58's dues, \$75/Cub** This year, the Pack will invoice all families in September 2024. Fundraising (popcorn sales) helps cover our expenses too. This year, there is an "Opt-out" of popcorn fundraising option: Dues \$200/Cub\*\* instead of \$75
4. **Pack 58 has a Scholarship Fund** to support families in need and cover their dues. Contact Mr. Rob w/questions.

- **Dens will be formed and assigned by the end of September.** These are smaller groups (8-10 Cubs, same grade) that usually meet 2 nights per month. You will be contacted with info regarding Den meeting details & times.
